(2023-24 ROWING SEASON)

NOTES:

- 1. The following charges are for season 2023-2024. They will be reviewed each season.
- 2. The charges for any particular regatta may vary from the standard if costs can be shared by adjacent regattas.
- 3. Hirers are responsible for loss or damage to installations or equipment. Any such loss or damage is to be reported in writing to the Secretary of the GRA at the time of the regatta.
- 4. The Geelong Rowing Association is registered for GST dated from 1st October 2020.

TOILETS AT REGATTAS

The spectator reserve (Morell Reserve) at the Barwon River rowing precinct has 5 public toilets. The toilets are not cleaned or serviced by the City of Greater Geelong on regatta days.

The Corio Bay Rowing Club, Barwon Rowing Club, Geelong College and Geelong Grammar usually have some toilets available for visiting oars-people. (This only occurs when those clubs are actually competing at the regatta).

In the past, when mobile toilets have been provided at regattas at the Barwon River, competitors have generally chosen to use club facilities. This is not preferred as the club facilities are private facilities and are costly for stocking (of toiletries and for cleaning and maintenance).

The Geelong Rowing Association Inc. has just built a new boatshed, the Jeff Sykes Rowing Centre for the storage of rowing boats for Geelong Secondary Schools with change rooms as

well as providing a regatta centre for rowing regattas on the Barwon River this includes the storage of regatta equipment buoys and speed boats etc as well as providing change rooms and toilet facilities for the regatta. This means that regatta hosting organisations do not need to hire 8 portable toilets for competitors at regattas (5 girls, 3 male which can be all designated female for female regattas) the disabled toilet being designated a unisex toilet. The charge to a regatta host for these toilets will be the same as the rate charged by the hire companies, and will be 5 @ \$110 or 8 @ \$110, plus cleaning and servicing costs below (regatta hosts will not have to pay the delivery fee for portable toilets). For most regattas we would expect that the host would be paying for 8 toilets.

The GRA can arrange for the toilets to be serviced and cleaned at the above clubs and the public toilets for \$265 per day (ex GST). The GRA offers this in order that regattas at the Barwon River which the GRA does not run, can provide acceptable toilet experiences, that do not reflect badly on rowing regattas on the Barwon River. It also means that the above Clubs do not have to clean and service toilets from their membership fees.
